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**MINUTES OF THE CHURCH SPECIAL-CALLED BUSINESS MEETING**  
March 21, 2010

The meeting was called to order by Greg Powell, Moderator, at 8:00 a.m.

Mr. Powell introduced Mike Reed, Chairman of the Finance Committee, who presented the motion to be voted on. "Motion to Make 4 additional quarterly payments. The Finance Committee recommends additional payments be made to the principal of the debt with Chase Bank utilizing *Building to Glorify* funds. Additional payments of \$27,110.53 will be made each quarter of the 2010 year (2010 year only). Total additional payment made to principal equals \$108,442.12."

Voting was by secret ballot.

A total of 392 ballots were cast  
378 ballots (96.3%) were Yes  
14 ballots (3.7%) were No

Our bylaws require two criteria when voting on expenditures exceeding \$50,000. First, a minimum of 10% of our resident members must cast ballots. Our resident membership is 1,920, so at least 192 had to cast ballots. This requirement was met. Second, a two-thirds majority of the ballots cast is required for the proposed change to pass; therefore, the motion to approve the expenditure passed.
